Past or current sets of Session Minutes may be submitted for review at any time. Please note that 2023 Session Minutes are due for review during 2024. The Work Group reviews Session Minutes alphabetically by church name. The schedule for the review of 2023 Session Minutes in 2024 is as follows:

February 15 – Churches with names beginning with F-M

May 4 – Churches with names beginning with N-W

October 24 – Churches with names beginning with A-D
