Greeting from Old Brick Presbyterian Church:

We want to say “Thank You” for your \$500 donation last year to our Food Pantry ministry. We started this ministry the first week of February, 2023. We converted some under-utilized church space to house the pantry and we were able to provide assistance to nearly 3400 individuals in 2023 and also we help with food items for other local pantries. We are open on Tuesday and Saturdays from 10am-noon. We ask shoppers to choose one of those days to shop. Some return each week shopping for themselves and/or others in their family; whereas, others may only come once or twice a month.

Some stay only long enough to get their needed items while others stay to hug, laugh, cry and pray. The Food Pantry volunteers have mentioned, on more than one occasion, how blessed they feel being a part of this ministry.

In addition to the food and fellowship that we offer, we collected school supplies during July and August to help food pantry families with this extra need. For Thanksgiving, 17 of our most struggling families, were provided with a turkey and all the food needed for a special Thanksgiving meal. As the weather turned colder, we provided blankets, coats, hats, gloves/mittens for those who needed the extra warmth. Two ladies designed special Christmas wreaths that were a big hit with our shoppers. Eight bikes were donated this Christmas and they found homes with some very excited children.

We continue to look for additional ways to show Christ’s love, compassion, and hope to our community. And we have been truly blessed to have other individuals, business and organizations within our community who have reached out asking “How can we help?”

The need is mind-blowing sometimes, but God is always faithful and our pantry continues to have the food to share.

Thanks you again for your support. Please pray that we are able to continue to meet the needs of so many.

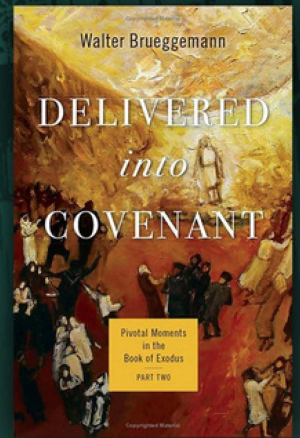
