On Saturday, April 13, the Racial Equity Subcommittee of the Justice and Mercy Commission sponsored a trip to visit Longwood University and the Moton Museum in Farmville, VA.

During lunch, University President, Dr. W.T.Reveley, and author, Ken Woodley, shared the history and impact of Prince Edward County's past segregated school system and its willingness to shutter public education from 1959-1964 rather than to desegregate.





