

Pastoral Wilderness Experience Survey

I am a Master of Divinity student at Pittsburgh Theological Seminary and a candidate in the ordination process under the care of the Pittsburgh Presbytery. I am in the beginning stages of designing and facilitating a restorative wilderness experience for pastors as part of my Adaptive and Innovative Ministry Emphasis project, as I seek to integrate my professional background in Adventure Education with my calling to ministry. I am gathering data from pastors to gauge the viability of this experience and learn about pastors' needs for restoration. The survey includes some more information about the experience. I am hoping that pastors far outside the Pittsburgh Presbytery will consider applying for this experience.

Coaching for thriving in ministry and life.

Ministers spend most of their time thinking about and serving others. There is precious little time--or permission--in their schedules to consider the patterns of behavior and thinking that might be getting in the way of making progress on personal and collective goals. If you are interested in strengthening your capacity to manage conflict, hold to boundaries, or engage in experiments to increase your leadership bandwidth, coaching is for you. If you want to learn more about adaptive leadership theory and practice, coaching is for you. If you want to consider new questions, and reframe old challenges, coaching is for you. All sessions are confidential. You set the goals. You set the pace.




