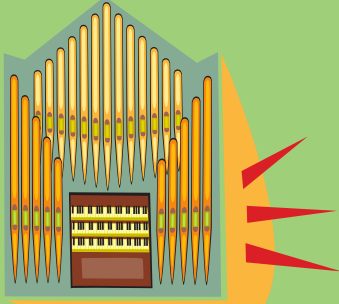

CEDEPCA TRIP UPDATE

Below is an excerpt from a letter written by Felecia Parsell, an Elder of Salem Presbyterian Church and a Commissioned Missional Pastor for the Roanoke Neighborhood, sharing her testimony from the CEDEPCA trip to Guatemala April 15-22, 2024.

...Our week's itinerary was full every day of wonderful experiences like a whole day of learning more about CEDEPCA's contributions and where our donations are used to provide clean water for families through eco-filters, the revolving fund which provides loans to families for the purpose of planting gardens so they can be self-sustaining, the Women's Program empowering self rights; self care; church leadership; and understanding laws as they pertain to equal relationships, and the Road to Emmaus Biblical and Theological Seminary preparing students for pastoral practice. The Bible tells us that it is more blessed to give than receive, and even if we only make a difference in just one life then we have lived our life making a difference for Christ.

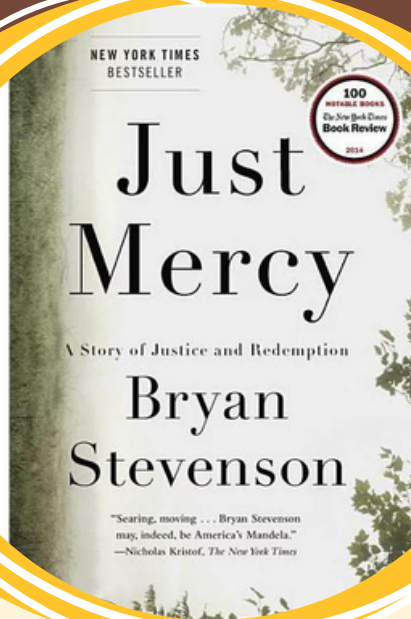
