

Forest Presbyterian Church Director of Music Advertisement

Forest Presbyterian Church in Forest, VA is seeking a part-time Director of Music.

Forest Presbyterian is located in Forest, Virginia off of Rt. 221 (Forest Road) next to the Forest Library. There is one weekly Sunday service at 10:30 am.

The Director of Music is responsible for planning, coordinating, and implementing all the music of Forest Presbyterian Church. The music program consists of a small choir (6-10 members), a 3-octave handbell choir, and children's chimes and choir. Duties are to include:

- Overseeing and giving directional leadership to the music ministry of the church by selecting music/programs, conducting regular choir rehearsals, developing, and assisting music ensembles, preparing long range music plans for the choir.
- Assisting the Pastor in developing the weekly order of worship service.
- Selecting songs and leading the congregational singing and instrumentalists at the Sunday Morning worship services and other special services as needed such as Christmas Eve, Maundy Thursday, and the occasional funeral.
- Selecting anthems and directing the singing of anthems by the choir at the Sunday Morning Worship service and other services as needed.
- In conjunction with the Worship and Music Committee, planning special music programs throughout the church year as needed.
- Serving as a member of the Worship and Music Committee and preparing an annual music budget to be presented to the Committee each September.

The position is estimated to require 8-10 hours weekly (lighter in summer and more at Christmas and Easter). The pay is \$10,000/year.
