1. Street Prayer ministry: This once a month endeavor in the warmer months has provided prayer for people on the streets in SE with the addition of food (in the form of snacks) and literature (Bibles, tracts, handouts, etc.) to encourage and love on those who walk our streets, and some who live on the streets.

2. Outdoor Concerts and picnics. Presbytery helped us provide good music and free food (burgers, dogs, sides) at a couple of outdoor events right here on 9th Street which is something we love to do and will continue to do.

3. Chainbreakers addiction groups: The funds from Presbytery helped us launch this endeavor which we have wanted to do for quite some time. We provide a meal each Thursday evening for the people attending.

4. An assortment of other outreaches for the community were enabled through the help of the grant. We did an Ash Wednesday outreach last year. We did a community St. Patrick's Day event with devotion food, and drawings for prizes. We bought Turkey's for some needy folks at Thanksgiving. We provided bag lunches for the Least of These Ministries. We bought blankets for those living on the streets. You get the idea, we were able to do more with the help of our grant from Presbytery.

So a big thank you for helping us do more than we could ever have done on our own! Our outreach continues and we are looking for some ways to expand our efforts to reach people with Jesus and His gospel. Blessings to you all and thank you!
