From 1894 to 1966, the Calfee Training School educated African American children in Pulaski, VA.

Faced with severe underfunding from Jim Crow segregation, the Calfee Training School became a community, helping children and families reach their full potential. During the Grand Opening on Saturday, September 28, Executive Director, Jill Williams explained that the Center will revitalize the positive aspects of Calfee's legacy, by supporting all of Pulaski County's children, families, and organizations to build a stronger future for the region.
