As of October 15th, PDA partner Church World Service had distributed almost 26,000 disaster related kits in areas impacted by hurricanes Helene and Milton.

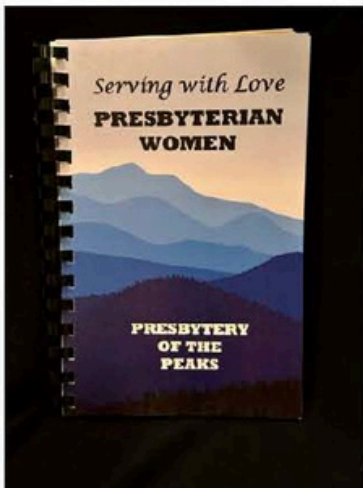


Then our buckets joined even more on the truck to western North Carolina.
