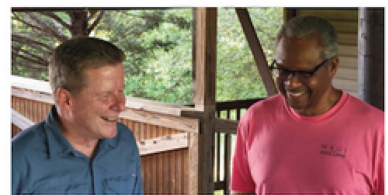

Some books in the Bible are about a specific person.
