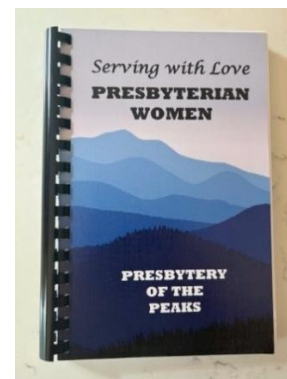


FEBRUARY IS BLACK HISTORY MONTH!

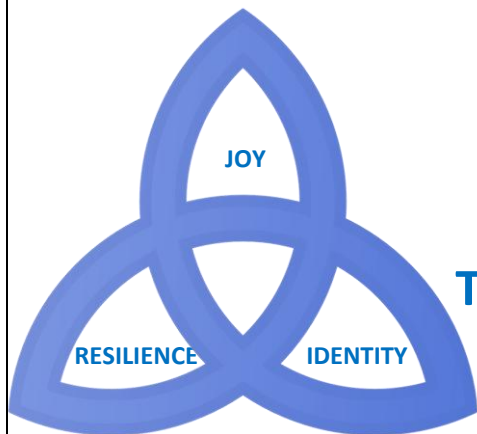
The PWCT meets only four times a year, either by Zoom or in person.
